



Workshop for Middle/High School Mathematics Teachers

SDSU will be offering a two day, one credit workshop for middle and high school math teachers at USDSU in Sioux Falls July 7th and 8th at a reduced tuition rate of approximately \$60. During the workshop, participants will:

- Learn to use software for creating technologically enhanced lessons and online lessons.
- Receive free copies of the software they learn to use, including the extremely useful Scientific Notebook computer algebra system and word processor.
- Be introduced to the National Science Digital Library and its resources for mathematics teachers.
- Create lessons that will be placed in the NSDL online collection.

This workshop was offered last year to an extremely positive response. In interviews with an independent reviewer of the workshop, several verbal reports from participants at the end of the second day indicated that in fact the session had been “revolutionary” and had “rescued” their fall term planning. This year’s workshop has been revised to incorporate more emphasis on software already to be found in most schools such as the Excel spreadsheet.
